Important Dates & Information

It is the Versatility Award competitor's responsibility to:

- 1) Bring your Score Card to the club event – Parades, Trail Rides, Clinics.
- 2) Let the Event Coordinator/Trail Host know that you are competing for the Versatility Award and find out who is responsible for signing your form.
- 3) On the trail rides, stay within close proximity of the person responsible for signing your record form so that person can clearly see how your horse is behaving.
- 4) At the completion of the event (on the day of the event), have the person responsible for signing your record form initial the form and write in the number of points that you earned. *(This is not necessary for the shows – the points will be calculated at the end of the season based on placings.)*
