Entry Fees: \$3.00 per class / \$5.00 office charge per rider/horse combination

- SRSC will have separate Year-End High Point Awards for the Walk-Trot classes. The Ranch classes will not count towards the Year-End High Point Awards.
- Leadline classes are non-qualifying for Year-End High Point Awards. Rider entering these classes cannot ride in Novice or Age Division classes. **Exception: *Tandem Bareback Walk-Trot (Class 4) may enter Age Division and loping/cantering classes.**
- Novice riders must choose Novice or Age Division classes; rider may not cross enter. **Exception: When Novice classes are not offered.** Novice: Based on **RIDER** not having placed 1st or 2nd in an Age Division class at any closed SRSC show, WSCA show, breed show, or has not received a Year-End High Point Award in Novice or in their Age Division.
- Riders must choose between Bridle Path and Western Pleasure classes. The horse may not enter both. **Bridle Path:** Horse with full and natural mane and tail, usually more animation at the gaits, such as Arabians or Morgans. **Western Pleasure:** Horse can have natural or pulled mane, stock-type horses, such as Quarter Horses, Paints, or Appaloosas.
- Entries in Walk-Trot classes are ineligible to ride in regular (Walk-Trot-Lope) classes, except for bareback.
- Contestants must wear proper attire in all classes. Head gear (helmet, Western hat, or appropriate English hat), long or short-sleeved shirt with a collar, long pants, and boots with heels.
- Committee decisions are final. Classes may be combined at the discretion of the Committee.

Age group is determined by the rider's age as of January 1, 2025. (Example: If a rider is 10 yrs old on January 1, 2025, but turns 11 on February 10, 2025, they will still compete in the 10 & under age group for the entire year.)

Classes in all CAPS and marked with ** will run in the following order:

When completing the entry card for classes in ALL CAPS and marked with ** put class # along with corresponding age group letter as shown above. (Example: 15 year old riding in class 20 Pole Weaving would put 20D on their entry card.)

To be eligible for Year-End High Point Awards each rider 13 years old & older must have at least 10 volunteer hours. Each rider 12 years old & under must have at least 5 volunteer hours. Volunteer hours can be provided by the SRSC member, a family member, or a friend.
